


# CESaRE Communications

## A Quick Guide

This explainer document will guide you through the general steps for the publication of CESaRE Communications.

### Main Steps



#### 1. Submission

For your submission to the Journal of CESaRE, to be considered for publication as a CESaRE Communications, select this article type before submitted your work. This paper type is one where scientific rigour is not as strong as full research articles, but clear impact is still possible through publication.

#### 2. Peer Review

The CESaRE Editor-in-Chief (EiC) will determine if submitted documents should be translated into CESaRE Communications. It is important to note that CESaRE Communications will also undergo the peer-review process but will not be held to the same standard but academic quality should not be compromised.

#### 3. CESaRE Communications

Submissions must be done using our template. These will still go through a partial review process by the Editorial Board to ensure necessary quality. All CESaRE Communications will be given a DOI as with our full research publications.

#### 4. Result

CESaRE Communications publications will be appended in a separate section in the relevant Journal of CESaRE Issue alongside full peer-reviewed articles. Pre-prints of both full research and Communications publications will be provided to authors before final online publication.

## Further Points to Consider

The Journal of CESaRE plans to change how science is communicated across the region. CESaRE Communications provides the opportunity for relevant research happening across the region to reach a wider audience, even if the peer-review process is not an appropriate avenue. The following steps outline the process whereby a document submitted to our Journal becomes a CESaRE Communications.



The Editorial Team will ensure that the submission is scientifically sound, well-formatted, and grammatically correct. The document with suggested edits will be returned to the author(s) for changes to be made.



Once the second submission is received, reviewed, and deemed ready for publishing, the EiC will give a final decision on the document. The author(s) is informed that the paper has been accepted for publication or not. It is important to note that some works may not be suitable for publication of any type and the EiC decides if the necessary scientific and research standards have been met.



The CESaRE Communications is sent to the marketing team for pre-prints to be generated and eventually published in the relevant Issue.

*If a CESaRE Communications submission has been rejected, the author(s) can ask for a further EiC review where the EiC holds full discretion to send the manuscript back to reviewers if discrepancies are found or reject the paper fully from publication.*
